

Ginger CEBTP resumes geotechnical activities along with surveys conducted by Arcadis on three sites in France

1st February 2017, Paris – On Friday 27 January 2017, Ginger CEBTP and Arcadis concluded a protocol for resuming geotechnical studies, carried out using Arcadis' own study tools in its agencies located in Quimper, Nantes and Dunkerque.

This agreement reintroduces the survey instruments from the three sites and takes over the staff, a team made up of 23 employees.

This transaction has led Ginger Group to complement its local network with two additional agencies (the Nantes' agency already existed) and to reinforce its national and local task force for one of its key activities – soil engineering.

For Arcadis, this transaction has enabled it to refocus (this was already done in other regions in the past) on its core business in the fields of infrastructure, building and the environment: engineering, prime contracting, operation management and advice, all the while maintaining its geotechnical engineering teams and expertise.
