This acquisition is an integral part of the growth strategy of the Ginger Group and its subsidiary Ginger DELEO. It will accelerate the company's development and enable it to cover the entire circular economy value chain.

For more than 10 years, RECOVERING has been providing a wide range of services related to the reuse of materials and the prevention and management of waste from economic activities and the construction and public works sector.
